

Green Swimming Pool Reporting

Unmaintained or green swimming pools can be a health and safety hazard to the entire neighborhood. They are breeding grounds for mosquitos that can carry diseases such as West Nile Virus, St. Louis Encephalitis, Dengue, Lyme Disease, Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever, Chikungunya, Malaria, Yellow Fever and Zika. The green cloudy water may make it difficult to see a drowning victim.

If you or a neighbor has a green pool you can, at no cost and subject to availability, obtain Gambusia fish from the Maricopa Vector Control Lab. These small fish will control Mosquitos by eating the Mosquito larva in the green pool.
